- **I**ncrease my knowledge of Laws of the Game
- **R**espectfully communicate to all Players, Officials and Parents in a positive and constructive manner
- **I**nform my Players' Parents of any injuries their Son/Daughter might have suffered during training and games
- **N**ever question the game or league official's judgement
- **P**rovide all Players equal playing time
- **T**each all players the conduct of fair play, respect and sportmanship
- **S**et an example of good behaviour to all Players, Parents and Club
- **N**ever ridicule or harass Players
- **R**ecognize and reward achievements other than scoring goals
- **P**romote respect through words and actions for the Laws of the game
- **U**se positive and constructive words and actions
- **P**repare age appropriate practice plans for all training sessions
- **E**nsure all players are actively participating in sessions
- **S**how up on-time to set-up training sessions and games
- **S**chedule practices and extra games in consideration of Family and Other obligations that may arise
- **D**ress appropriately as a coach at all games and practices to set a professional image
