
PARENT'S Code of Conduct



As a **PARENT** representing the **Mission Soccer Club**, I will:

- **R**emember that my child plays soccer for his or her enjoyment, not mine
- **N**ot force my child to participate in soccer
- **N**ot give playing instructions to players during training sessions and games
- **E**ncourage my child to play by the rules
- **E**ncourage my child to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence
- **T**each my child that doing one's best is as important as winning
- **M**ake my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and trying hard
- **N**ever ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game
- **R**emember that children learn best by example applaud good plays/performances by both my child's team and their opponents
- **N**ever question the game or league official's judgement
- **S**upport all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the children's sporting activities
- **R**espect and show appreciation for the officials who gave their time to provide sport activities for my child
- **M**ake every effort to ensure my child shows up on time for scheduled training sessions and games
- **R**ealize that the team can be penalized for my behaviour and that I must abide by the rules and the Officials at the field
- **M**ust stand on the opposite side of the field from the Players and Coaches
- **N**ot step onto the field of play during the game or designated training areas to avoid injury to myself or to players
- **W**ait 24 hours before contacting any coaching official and talk to them privately to resolve any issues that may have arisen during a game or training session
